3. Hazards Identification

These products contain hydroxy propyl methacrylate, which is a recognised skin irritant and all unnecessary skin contact should be avoided. Damaged skin should not come into contact with the uncured liquid. The presence of less than 5% of Acrylic Acid also requires that skin and eye contact should be avoided. Draize evaluation indicates that these materials would be moderate-to-strong eye irritants. These products are otherwise non-toxic. Wash all contaminated skin after use.

4. First Aid Measures

Inhalation: ***Not liable to cause any problems but should the user feel unwell, remove them to fresh air.***
